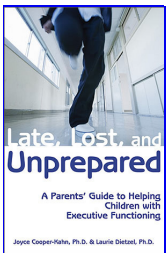

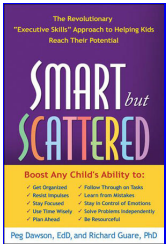

• Executive Functioning

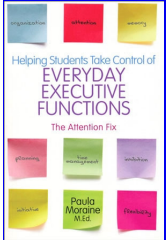

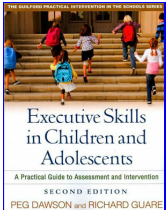

The Behavior Rating Inventory of Executive Functioning (BRIEF) consists of 3 evaluations depending on age. The tests for preschoolers ([BRIEF-P: ages 2 to 6 years](#)) and older students ([BRIEF: ages 5 to 18 years](#)) involve parent and teacher input. A separate test for adolescents ([BRIEF-Self Report: ages 11 to 18 years](#)) asks the student to self-evaluate his/her own purposeful, goal-directed, problem-solving behavior.



[Lessons for the Right Brain](#) is a five workbook series for addressing several executive function skills- [Memory](#), [Thought Organization](#), [Self-Perception/Functional Information](#), [Reading and Writing](#) and [Visual Perception and Attention](#). 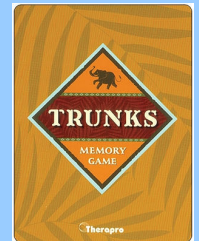

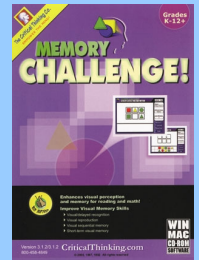

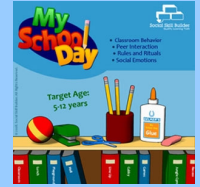
