I received the [Herbert J Hall Award](#) from [Massachusetts Association for Occupational Therapy \(MAOT\)](#) this past Friday at their Annual Conference. I was one of four award recipients, each one serving both the Occupational Therapy and the broader community in unique and different ways. I am proud to be an OT, and humbled to be among those honored at the conference.



The awards were part of the Annual Business meeting which was enlivened by a presentation by MAOT's lobbyist, Lisa Simonetti. She discussed legislation affecting the OT Profession in the Commonwealth of Massachusetts including potential effects of the Affordable Care Act. This stimulated an active question and answer period. The message was: if you want to be heard, this is the perfect forum for it. Your State Organization is there to represent you but you have to tell them what needs to be done.



One of the recipients, an OT who has become an international public policy and health care advocate for people with disabilities, related an anecdote from the recent [American Public Health Association](#) conference. When asked how she became interested in disabilities, she answered that "if we can get health care right for people with disabilities, then we will be able to get health care for everyone right."

There were lots of messages at this meeting; these are the ones I took away.

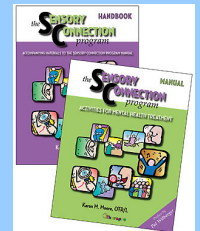
