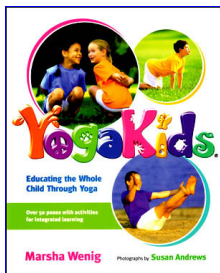


Our schedule is filling up! We're excited to announce that we've added two new seminars at the end of 2015 to our [Saturday Seminar Series](#).

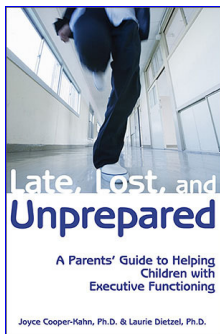

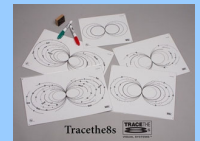
